

Survival

You will be carrying a #10 can. It will contain all the gear you can take on the survival portion of the campout. Content you may want to consider for your can might include the following. These are ideas only and you may come up with many other items and skip several of these. Not everyone will need water purification tablets as one bottle will support the entire troop on one campout.

- Something to hold water and possibly more than one (one on your person)
- Duct tape rapped around a water bottle
- Very large trash bag or two for rain protection and warmth for sleeping
- Rain coat that packs very small
- Plastic sheet for ground cloth or part of shelter
- Some seasoning for food (salt and pepper)
- Utility tool (knife, pliers, etc.) or separate knife and pliers.
- Spoon if not on your utility tool
- Material from your personal survival kit
- Water purification stuff (optional since could be done by boiling)
 - o Purification Tablets (could share with several others)
 - o Neutralizer (could share with several others)
 - o Water bottle filter
- Wire
- Small bit of old cloth (few square feet)
- Line (braided fishing line or regular fishing line if don't have braided)
- Fish hooks
- Thin nylon string/rope (30 or 40 feet, maybe more)
- Fire starting stuff in small container
 - o Matches
 - o Char-cloth
 - o Sparker
 - o Cotton soaked in Vaseline
- Small trowel (troop will supply)
- Small flash light
- Toilet paper (small part of role)
- Several sizes of zip-lock baggies
- Anything else you can think of...
